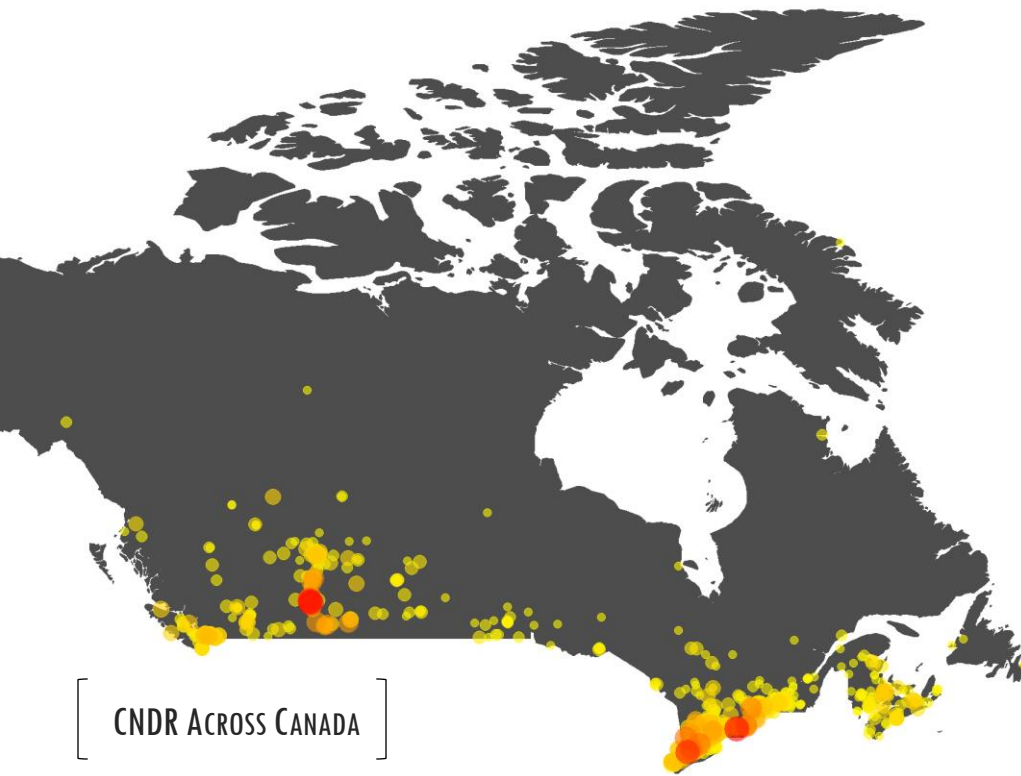

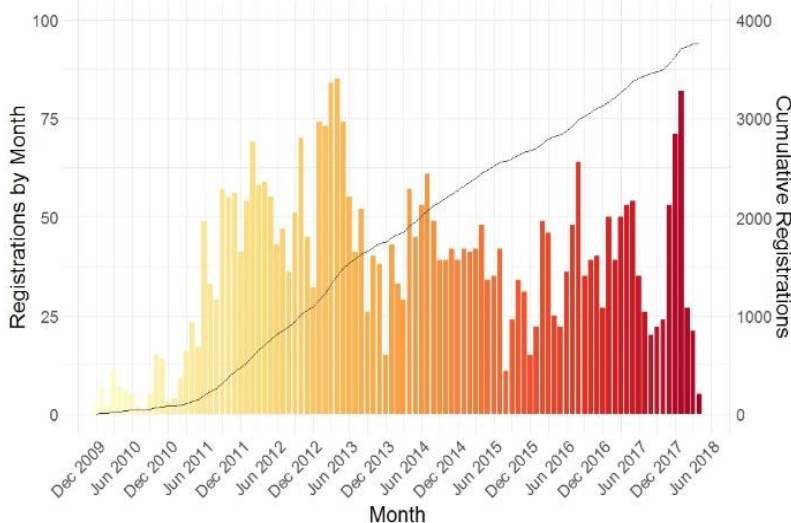

Over **3700 people** are registered in CNDR, from 25 neuromuscular clinics and 13 ALS clinics across the country

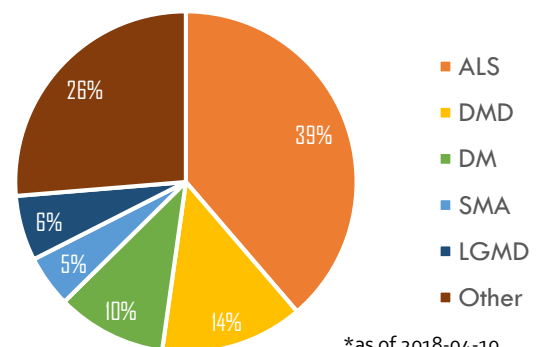
